In addition to SWALCO's mobile events held from spring through fall at locations throughout Lake County, residents can drop-off their household chemical waste, quickly and easily, year-round (on selected dates and by appointment only), at the Gurnee facility, 1311 N. There will be multiple public drop-offs scheduled at the facility each month, including the 2nd Saturday of the month. You can sign up for one of the available time slots and will receive an email confirmation of your appointment.
