

## CHAPTER 72: PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES

#### **§72.01 SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE.**

The term SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE shall mean any rural, arterial or collector street during a snowfall of two (2) inches or more of accumulation.

#### **§72.02 PARKING PROHIBITED.**

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on a Snow Emergency Route in the Village within 24 hours of a snowfall of two (2) inches or more of accumulation.
- (B) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle in such a manner as to impede snow or ice clearing efforts by the Village of Deer Park or its authorized agents.

#### **§72.03 REMOVAL OF VEHICLES AUTHORIZED.**

Any vehicle parked on a Snow Emergency Route when parking is prohibited by Section 72.02 above may, at the order of the Lake County Sheriff's Office, be removed to a storage facility previously designated by the Lake County Sheriff's Office. Said removal shall be at the sole cost and expense of the owner of the vehicle.
